2.8.4 Bridge Rehabilitation

In the second half of each year the Department normally issues a circular inviting applications for funding in respect of Bridge Rehabilitation Works for the following year. A list of candidate Bridge Rehabilitation projects should be drawn up by Local Authorities for submission to the Department. Projects should be listed in order of priority. Bridge Condition Ratings (1 to 5) should be included where available and priority will initially be given to addressing bridges with higher condition ratings.

Such works should have a **minimum project cost of €15,000 (incl VAT)** but can be less in certain circumstances and if agreed with the Department Inspector. Proposals for individual bridge rehabilitation/repair projects costing in **excess of €200,000 (incl. VAT)** are outside of the scope of this scheme and fall to be considered under the Specific Grant Programme. An

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inspection/investigation proposal by consultants/specialist (catering for one or more bridges) can also be included in a Local Authority's application list.

While it is not necessary for Local Authorities to seek approval to transfer funding among the approved bridge schemes that are notified to Local Authorities as part of the grants allocation process at the start of each year, the Department **must be notified in writing** of such transfers as they occur during the year. Where Local Authorities wish to introduce a new scheme, for example if implementation of an approved scheme is delayed, then **prior approval** should be sought from the Department. At the end of each year the Department will seek confirmation of outputs in respect of bridge works.

MEMORANDUM ON GRANTS FOR REGIONAL AND LOCAL ROADS



EFFECTIVE 1 DECEMBER 2018

Bridge Rehabilitation

- 270 projects are being funded in 2019 at a cost of €10.7m
- Applications for 2020 were recently sought

Bridge Works under the Bridge Rehabilitation Programme Proposals for Funding in 2020

Dear Director of Services,

The Department of Transport, Tourism & Sport is now inviting applications for Bridge Works under the Regional & Local Road Bridge Rehabilitation Grant Programme, for consideration for funding in 2020.

Each local authority is invited to submit a number of applications for bridge rehabilitation and repair works, the total of which should not exceed 130% of your 2019 bridge allocation. Submissions which exceed that amount will be considered non-compliant and returned.

The minimum project cost for each grant application is €15,000 (incl. VAT) but can be less in certain circumstances and if agreed with your Inspector. Where boundary changes have been implemented in respect of a City/County Council's jurisdiction since January 2019, the total bridge application funding sought should not exceed a threshold agreed with your Inspector.

A summary of applications (Appendix 1) for funding in 2020 should be submitted, setting out the projects in priority order. In addition Local Authorities are requested to submit an Application form (Appendix 2) in respect of each scheme. Bridge Condition Ratings (1 to 5) should be included where available and priority should be given to addressing bridges with higher condition ratings.

Both appendices must be submitted no later than **Thursday 3rd October 2019 to RLR@dtas.gov.ie** in order to be considered for funding.
